

2026 Mid-Atlantic Region VMCCA Spring Tour

Come join us for a Mid-Atlantic Region VMCCA **Spring Tour, May 17-20, 2026** in Altoona and Johnstown, PA and Environs. Registration will be Sunday, May 17, 2026 (2pm to 4pm) with the tour beginning Monday and concluding Wednesday the 20th.

Tentative plans include Johnstown, generally noted for the historic 1889 flood that resulted from a dam upstream collapsing and repeating in 1936, and again as late as 1977 - a museum tells the story (note tree trunk thru upper level window. Also popular, is riding the Inclined railway with a 70 % grade built in 1890 to carry people, horses and wagons to an up-hill community accessible only by the steep 70% grade from one level to the other.




There is also the Izett Heritage Museum - a partnership of the Izett family and Juniata College that houses art, history, and science collections.

In Altoona, there is Lenny's Classic Car Collection, of 30 classic cars featuring such classic cars as Jaguars, Rolls Royce, Thunderbirds, etc. all dramatically displayed in unusual and attractive ways.

Also, near Altoona the famous horseshoe curve – an unbelievable bend in the tracks near Altoona. And, the Railroad Museum at what is known as Railroad City in Altoona.
